## COMMUNITY VISION & COUNCIL PLAN – COMMUNITY POP-UPS & SURVEY

Stage two of the Hepburn Together Project is currently underway. The development of the 10 Year Community Vision and 4 Year Council Plan are important tools to establishing our goals, aspirations and priorities.

Mayor, Cr Lesley Hewitt, said while it is a legislative requirement that Council develop these strategic documents, it wants these documents to be community driven.

“We are consulting widely with the community on the development of these documents. We’re listening to feedback so that these documents reflect our community’s aspirations,” said Cr Hewitt.

Council has already facilitated 5 community pop-up sessions in our larger townships and there are another 10 sessions coming to smaller hamlets around the Shire over the coming two weeks.
