COUNCIL AWARDS COMMUNITY GRANTS

Congratulations to Daylesford and District Horticultural Society, Daylesford Lawn Tennis Club, Creswick and District Senior Citizens and Sprung Circus Incorporated, who will share in \$8,559.42 as part of Hepburn Shire Council's first round of grants for 2021/2022.
