Put your recycling bin (yellow lid) out on the faded colour week.

The red lid bin for landfill (general waste), goes out fortnightly on the alternating week (bright colour).

Place your bin out the night before collection day, with the correct placement.

## Correct bin placement

- One metre off the road, well clear of traffic
- Bin opening facing the road, with wheels and handle facing your house
- Clear of low overhanging branches or powerlines
- Bin lid properly closed and not overfull
- Bins more than 50cm apart from one another

## Public Holidays with no collection

### New Years Day

Saturday 1 January - no change

### Good Friday

Friday 15 April  
– collection Saturday 16 April

### Christmas Day

Sunday 25 December – no change

Check the calendar for the colour corresponding to your area for your collection day.

## What CAN I recycle?

### Paper

All types of paper including magazines, pamphlets, note pads, envelopes and office paper.

### Cardboard

Not waxed cardboard.  
Remove food scraps.

### Plastic bottles and containers

Those with numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5  
Remove bottle lids, dispose of at Customer Service Centres/Hubs or Transfer Stations collection points.

### Glass bottles and jars

Remove lids and food. Keep unbroken where possible.

### Food Cans

Remove all visible liquid and food. Labels can remain on.

### Aerosol cans

Empty.

### Aluminum Foil

Scrunched into ball.  
>5cm diameter.

## What is NOT recyclable in your kerbside bin?

- Bagged recycling
- Building waste
- Polystyrene
- Clothes
- Soft plastics, including plastic bags, wrappers
- Plastic lids from bottles, this includes juice & milk containers
- Food and garden waste
- Takeaway cups and coffee pods
- Liquid paperboard (including Tetra Pak, UHT containers, milk & juice cartons)
- e-waste  
Electronic and electrical items (including batteries)
- Black plastic items (even if 1, 2, 3, 4, 5)
- Windows and drinking glass, crockery
- Shredded paper
