Penalties apply if animals are not registered.

Council's Local Law restricts the number of pets that can be kept in a certain area. Further information can be obtained from Council.

Keeping pets in excess of the prescribed number requires Council approval.

Replacements for lost or damaged tags are available from Council's service centres.

From 1 May 2007, State Government legislation requires all pets registered for the first time, or registered for the first time in Hepburn Shire, or that do not have current registration with Hepburn Shire **to be microchipped before Council can accept a registration application.**

PENSIONERS: If you are an eligible recipient within the meaning of the State Concessions Act (i.e. If you hold a Pensioner Concession Card) you are entitled to a 50% reduction in fees. **Please Note: Health Care Cards are not included.**

► IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Victorian Government levy: As of 1 July 2026, the Victorian Government Levy is \$9 for every registration or renewal collected for a dog or cat. The levy helps fund responsible pet ownership education programs, animal welfare initiatives, research into domestic animal management, and the administration of the Domestic Animals Act 1994. Examples include educational materials for councils, legislative reform, and training or courses for both the public and authorised officers. The levy is included in the registration fee.

You are eligible for a reduced registration fee if your pet is:

- De-sexed, a desexing certificate must be supplied.
- Over 10 years of age.
- Kept for working stock, the property address must be rated as farm, and the dog must be of a working dog breed.
- Kept for breeding by the proprietor of a registered domestic animal business.
- Has an obedience certificate that is either issued by or is registered to an applicable association.

Applicable associations are:

- Australian National Cats Inc.
- Dogs Victoria
- Feline Control Council (Victoria) Inc.

- The Governing Council of the Cat Fancy Australia and Victoria Inc
- Master Dog Breeders & Associates
- Responsible Pet Breeders Australia.

Pensioners: Pensioners who have approved concession cards issued by the Department of Social Services and Department of Veterans Affairs are also entitled to a reduction in their fees.
