Penalties apply if animals are not registered.

Council's Local Law restricts the number of pets that can be kept in a certain area. Further information can be obtained from Council.

Keeping pets in excess of the prescribed number requires Council approval.

Replacements for lost or damaged tags are available from Council's service centres.

From 1 May 2007, State Government legislation requires all pets registered for the first time, or registered for the first time in Hepburn Shire, or that do not have current registration with Hepburn Shire to be microchipped before Council can accept a registration application.

▶ IMPORTANT INFORMATION

State Government levy: The State Government levy of \$3.50 per dog registration and \$2.00 per cat registration is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership education programs. The levy is included in the registration fee.

If you wish to claim a REDUCED FEE, the following rules apply:

- Desexed/Over 10 years/Per ID – if not previously supplied, a vet certificate or statement OR completion of the statutory declaration below.
- Working Dog – the property address must be rated as a FARM and the dog must be an appropriate breed.
- Breeding/Trained/Association – if not previously supplied, satisfactory documentary evidence to support claim.

Your responsibilities as a pet owner:

- Failure to register a Dog or Cat – 2 penalty units
- Dog or Cat found wandering at large during the daytime – 1.5 penalty units
- Dog or Cat wandering at large during the night – 2 penalty units
- Dog or Cat found at large without registration tag – 0.5 penalty unit
- If your Dog rushes at, attacks, worries or chases any person or animal – 1 penalty unit
- A Dog or Cat must not cause a nuisance – 0.5 penalty unit

Change of Details: Should the address on this notice be incorrect or if your pet is deceased, Council must be notified in writing. All correspondence should be forwarded to Hepburn Shire Council, P.O. Box 21, Daylesford, Vic 3460 or email shire@hepburn.vic.gov.au
