EOI OPEN FOR TRENTHAM COMMUNITY HUB PROJECT CONTROL GROUP

Council is calling for expressions of interest for the Project Advisory Group for the Trentham Community Hub.

The Trentham Community Hub is a key project for the Trentham and Coliban Ward community, and once completed, will provide integrated services including library, Council customer service and Visitor Information Services. The facility will also include community meeting and hall spaces.

Mayor, Cr Don Henderson, said that the delivery of this project would mean a significant improvement in the way the Trentham and Coliban community accessed services.

“The Trentham Community Hub will more adequately meet the current and future demand for services as the population grows and changes. The Project Advisory Group will play an important role in the development of the concept design for the facility,” said Cr Henderson.

After a community survey, Council resolved to develop the Trentham Community Hub at the location of the Mechanics Institute, incorporating the original parts of the Mechanic’s Institute Hall into the new facility.

The next stage is to develop designs for the Trentham Community Hub, and the Project Advisory Group is a key part of helping realise the vision for this facility.

This is a great chance to represent the diverse community interests of Trentham and the Coliban Ward on what will be a significant project for the community.
