

# CLUNES TOWN HALL & POLICE COURT HOUSE REMEDIAL WORKS

## PRIORITY PROJECTS



- Preservation of historic and icon building
- Improve community facilities
- Supporting major events
- Supporting regional education opportunities

## PROJECT DETAILS

Restoring the 1873 Town Hall to its original grandeur will not only preserve this historic building but will enable full community use to be reinstated. The Clunes Town Hall will support significant community events such as the annual Booktown, private functions, education programs and provide a tourism opportunity with the restoration of the historically significant court house. The rare example of a combined courthouse and Town Hall is also a major attraction for Wesley College's curriculum with history and drama classes and re-enactments of historical court proceedings being considered. A program of restoration works has already completed with structural underpinning of the building and further interior works underway (Stage A) to secure the internal arches and some wall rendering.

### STAGES B & C

More significant restoration works are required of the restoration. Stages B would include Police Court House remedial works to accommodate the needs of the community. Stage C would include repairs to the exterior portico, the upstairs former clerical offices, upgrade of toilet facilities to meet current standards, heating and overall accessibility.
