

# CRESWICK TOWN HALL

### PROJECT DETAILS

Creswick Town Hall is a much-loved and iconic building. The Hall and Municipal Offices were constructed as one building in 1876, thirteen years after the creation of the Borough of Creswick. The Town Hall is utilised for community use and houses the Creswick Museum and Research Centre as well as exhibition and gallery space with displays of Creswick's famous artists 'The Lindsay's'.

The project will include remedial works identified in the recently completed Conditions Survey by Heritage Consultants. This package of works will include addressing water egress issues through roofing and roof plumbing, some electrical work, painting and addressing some structural cracking.
