## Cornish Hill Trail - Daylesford

**Distance:** 5 km

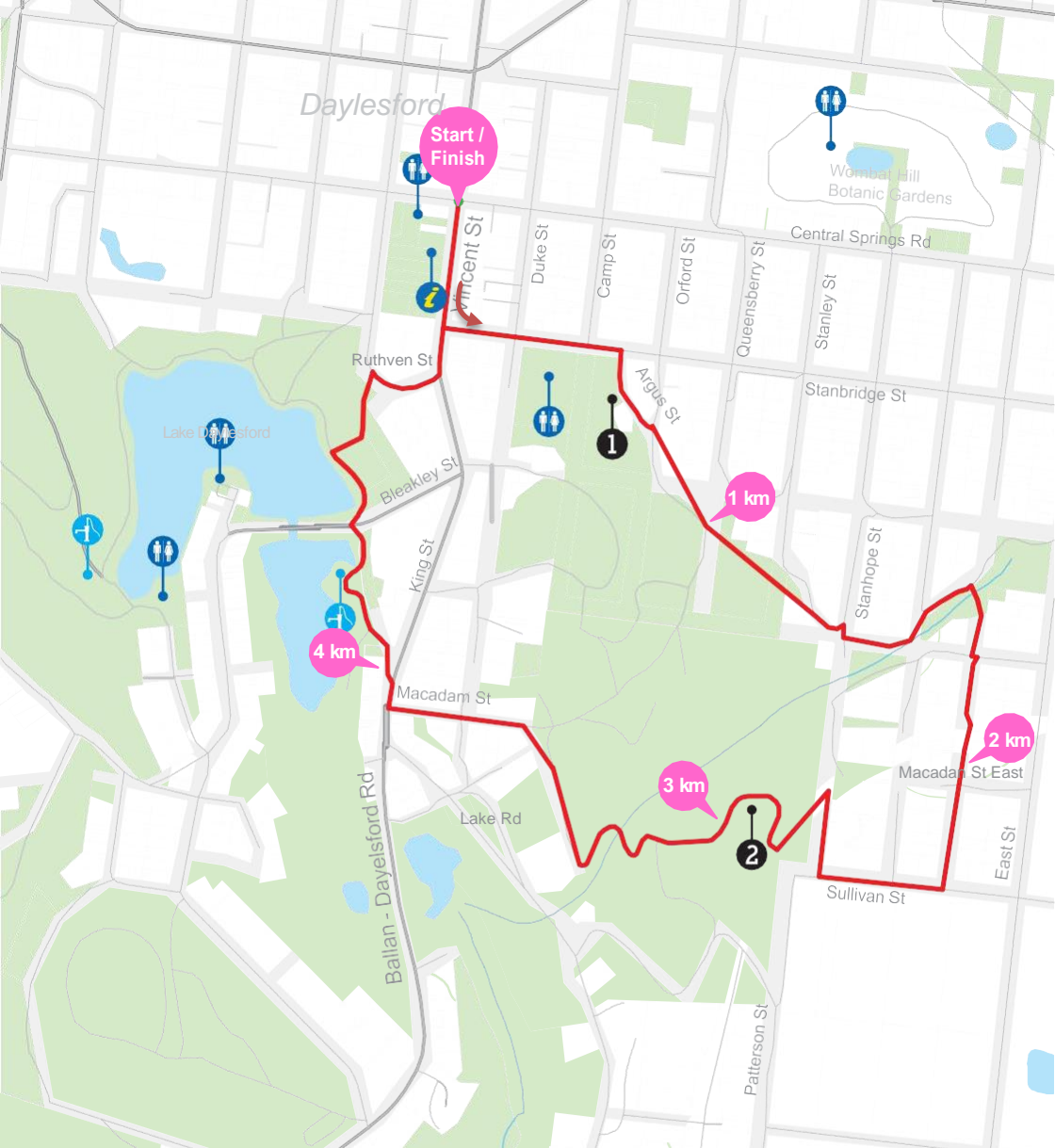
**Time:** 2 hours

**Grading:** 

Start this trail opposite the Visitor Information Centre on Vincent Street, and walk up to the stunning Thomas' Lookout on Argus Hill. Continue following the pink 'Hepburn Girls Can' signage along the trail, turning right at the old Trout Hatchery to head up through the old gold mining area of Cornish Hill. Note all the work the Friends of Cornish Hill have done on removing weeds and replanting native vegetation. Finish the last stretch of this walk alongside Lake Daylesford and back up to the centre of town. A high grading walk, but with beautiful views along the way, this walk is well worth the effort.

*Look for the 'Hepburn Girls Can' signs and take a selfie!*

1. Enjoy a beautiful view over the forest surrounding Dayslesford. View the location of a plaque acknowledging the contribution of the Cornish miners of the area.
2. Stand above the dis-used Cornish Hill goldmine shaft - imagine miners working to extract gold from the quartz in the 1800s.
